The Norwegian company, Normeca As, has signed a contract with the health authorities in Norway for the delivery of 852 protection suits, to be distributed to all emergency hospitals in Norway. In addition, 15 complete decontamination units will be delivered to 15 central- and regional hospitals all over Norway. The specific hospitals which will receive the decontamination units will be decided at a later stage.

As part of the agreement, Normeca AS, will provide 2 days training in decontamination and use of the equipment, for up to 30 persons for each hospital receiving the decontamination units. Normeca AS will also assist all the emergency hospitals in training for use of the protection suits.

Last week Normeca AS signed a similar agreement with the Norwegian Civil Defence Authority. The first 2 decontamination units have already been delivered, and more than 70 persons have been trained in use of the equipment. The total value of the contracts, including tents, heaters, electric generators and detection equipment for chemical gas, is approx. NOK 55 mill, and the equipment will be delivered before year end. After the delivery of this equipment, Norway will have one of the world's highest standards of protective material in case of chemical accidents and terrorist attacks with offensive chemical weapons.
